#### TRANSFER OF STABLE OBGYN PATIENTS FROM ED TO BAS OB GYN URGENT CARE AFTER MSE

## Candidates for transferring patients from ED to BAS Ob Gyn Urgent Care (BOUC)

Women without ILI sx AND the following Gyn complaint but not limited to:

- Vaginal bleeding
- Pelvic pain (below umbilicus)
- Pregnant ( <20 weeks) + VB or abd pain or both</li>
- Urgent Vulvar or labial complaints (e.g. Bartholin abscess)
- Acute urinary retention requiring catherization or pessary treatment

#### 1. MSE CRITERIA:

# **Exclusion criteria** to send pts to BAS OB Gyn Urgent Care (BOUC):

- Age <12, if age 12-18 at discretion of Peds Urgent Care's approval to send patient to BOUC
- 2. Influenza Like Illness (ILI) +
- 3. Significant abdominal or pelvic pain: defined as Pain score> 6/10
- 4. Dizziness
- 5. Significant vaginal bleeding: defined as soaking > 1 pad per hour
- 6. Refusal to be transferred to Bascom clinic
- 7. Vital signs abnormalities:

Temperature > 100.0

- BP < 90/50 or> 160/110
- Heart rate (beats per min) <50 or >120
- Respiratory rate (breaths per min) <10 or >30
- Oxygen saturation on room air, at sea level, % <95

### **Process after MSE:**

- 1. ED to draw stat labs (CBC, T&S, quant HCG)
- 2. Call BAS OB Gyn urgent care RN at 408 885 4669 to given patient info, (MR, name), and chief complaint.
- 3. Discharge patient from ED (with EMTALA waiver to be approved by HCC)
- 4. Send pt to 750 Bascom Ave, Ob Gyn BAS Suite 300 to check in at front desk.
